National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP)	Math & Reading	4 & 8	NAEP measures student achievement and report change in student performance over time in America. Schools and grade levels are chosen yearly at random.	National	90-120 minutes	February 2022	National and State results are reported to the public on the Nation's report card.
SAT 10 Homeschool Testing	Core Subjects	4, 8 & 11 homeschool students	Summative assessment measuring various areas of achievement for homeschool students.	State	2 hours	testing window: March 25-April 19	Individual results are sent home at the end of May.
NWEA MAP	Math & Reading	K-5	Assessment to measure yearly progress and growth of students and across grade levels.	District	2 hours per test (2 tests)	Fall, Winter & Spring	Individual results are viewed by teachers and are shared during conferences.
Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB)	Verbal, Math & Science/Technical Skills	11	Assessment for career planning and gathering information on specific skill areas. ASVAB is also used used to determine strength and potential success in military training.	District	3 hours	September 22, 2021	Individual results are given to students during an interpretation session.
PSAT/NMSQT	Reading, Writing & Language, and Math	11	Standardized test that provides practice for the SAT and is the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.	District (optional)	4 hours	October 13, 2021	Individual results are given to students during an interpretation session.
National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC)	Applied Math, Graphic Literacy & Workplace Documents	12	A skills test that matches abilities in work-related situations. Students have the opportunity to share their certificate with future employers and provide evidence of job skills.
